PERIOPERATIVE STREAM

Maitland Private Hospital offers a unique program allowing graduate nurses to rotate through & experience all areas of Perioperative nursing including; PACU, Scrub/Scout & Anaesthetics. It will consist of 3 x 6 month rotations, on an 18 month fixed-term contract with a potential for permanent employment.

The position offered will be eight days per fortnight.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

1. Completion of your Nursing Degree (Bachelor or Masters) prior to the commencement date.
2. AHPRA registration prior to commencement.
3. Current Working with Children Check and Police Check.
4. Immunisation evidence (including COVID vaccination) and serology report.

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

1. Previous under-graduate experience in hospital setting.
2. Previous perioperative nursing experience.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. You're passionate about a career in Perioperative Nursing
2. Commitment to continuous quality improvement and safety.
3. Demonstrated ability to work effectively within a team.
4. Strong collaborative interpersonal skills with well-developed verbal and written communication skills.
5. Demonstrated clinical knowledge and clinical problem-solving abilities.
6. Exhibit patient-centred care with an understanding of the professional, ethical and legal requirements of the role.

As part of your application you will be required to provide a personal statement (maximum 350 words). Your statement must describe your interest in Perioperative Nursing & why you have chosen this specialty. It may also include your most valuable skills & past experiences.

During recruitment your responses will be reviewed as part of the selection process. It is important that you give your statement thoughtful consideration.

Working With Children Check	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- NSW Working with Children Check (WWCC) clearance number for paid work by visiting https://www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/- You must bring a WWCC clearance number to interview for verification.
Immunisation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Evidence of current immunisation in accordance with NSW Health
Referees Identify two referees in your application:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- One referee must be a clinical referee.- The second referee is to be either an employer (paid or unpaid work) or another clinical referee. The names and contact details (phone & email) of your two referees are to be entered with pre-employment check information prior to interview.
